The Certificate in [Nonprofit Leadership and Philanthropy](#) is collaboratively administered by the School of Journalism and Mass Communication, and the Department of Management and Organizations. The certificate is awarded by University College.

The certificate meets the needs of students who have a desire to prepare for a career in a nonprofit role and/or who may impact the nonprofit sector through volunteering on a board, committee, or project.
